The following Code of Conduct must be read and signed annually by all WSY swimmers and their parents.

Expected Behavior at all WSY activities:

1. Act and conduct myself with dignity and respect for others and the property of others.
2. Always practice and teach good sportsmanship.
3. Promote positive high team spirit and morale.
4. Offer congratulations to my opponents, win or lose, and to cheer on my teammates.
5. Be a responsible goodwill ambassador between the sport of swimming and the public, as well as representing the West Shore YMCA in the appropriate manner

Prohibited Behavior at all WSY activities:

1. Use of alcoholic beverages.
2. Use of illegal drugs.
3. Smoking or other use of tobacco products.
4. Destructive behavior, including defacing lockers in any locker room.
5. Inappropriate or unruly behavior, including failure to adhere to team standards.
6. Theft of any kind

At Travel Meets:

There is a separate code of conduct for travel meets that all WSY swimmers and parents will sign prior to departure
